The word “Church” is a big word. It has lots of meanings, all of them valid, all of them important. We use the word “Church” in so many different ways. It can mean...

- the greater Church, around the world.
- our denominational “Church,” like the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ.)
- a place we go to, a local church.
- we are going to worship or to a meeting or an event.
- a group of people who are affiliated with a particular religious group, like our church.

There are probably more ways we use the word “Church” but the point is that “Church” means a great deal to us. It is a part of our lives and for many of us, we would be lost without the multiple ways “Church” affects and influences our lives.

The greater and local manifestation of the “Church” means a lot to me, knowing that I am not alone and neither is my church. But probably my most frequent reference to the church is the same one you use, and is likely the same for the majority of us: going to “Church” for worship, a meeting or an event. Going to “Church” is as natural a part of our lives as eating—or anything that nourishes and sustains us.

The thoughts above were prompted by a story I heard recently. It seems a church-goer wrote a letter to the editor of a newspaper observing that it made

no sense to go to church every Sunday. “I’ve gone to church now for 30 years,” he wrote, “and in that time I’ve heard something like 3000 sermons.” [I wondered about his claim—that’s 100 sermons per year. And you think you’ve got it bad. Anyway, “Church” is more than the sermon.] The writer continued, “For the life of me, I can’t remember a single one of them. So, I think I’m wasting my time and the pastors are wasting theirs by giving sermons at all.”

The letter started a real controversy in the city where the writer lived and it all played out in the local newspaper. Dozens of people who had never dreamed of writing to the editor of the newspaper weighed in on the topic for weeks, both pro and con. Finally, someone wrote a letter that sealed the debate. This writer said: “I’ve been married for 30 years. In that time my wife has cooked some 32,000 meals. But, for the life of me, I cannot recall the entire menu for a single one of those meals. But I do know this...they all nourished me and gave me the strength I needed to do my work. If my wife had not given me these meals, I would be physically dead today. Likewise, if I had not gone to church for nourishment, I would be spiritually dead today!”

Maybe this story speaks to you—it did me. I heard someone say once: “Faith sees the invisible, believes the incredible and receives the impossible.” That statement kinda sums up why “Church” means so much to us.

**JOB DESCRIPTIONS
and THANKS!**

Have you ever written a job description? There is a real art to doing so! As a part of my employment I have written some job descriptions and helped re-organize and re-define some personnel changes. It's always fascinating to see different perspectives, even for something that seems fairly simple! That's also true in our church family.

Several members of the elected church leadership have been involved in writing the job descriptions for the church custodian, church secretary and church financial secretary. They've done an excellent job of creating a brief overview of jobs which contain so many different skills! Of course, it's impossible to list every task which would be required for any job. The job description is a basic tool, followed by interviews, training, ongoing experience, etc. Growth occurs at each stage, just as it does in the Christian life.
