"The Chosen" Season Two Study

<u>Tuesday, September 3, 2:00-3:30 p.m.</u> in multi-Purpose Room is the place for "The Chosen" Season Two Study. It is an 8-week study. There is a Study Guide for each participant to help understand each episode of "The Chosen". The cost will be \$8.25. There will be a signup sheet by the church office. Come experience Biblical Characters in a new way through video and discussion. "The Chosen" is not a biblical story as revealed in the Scriptures, but it is a story which contains the Scriptures and provides us with a possibility of how things may have taken place. It is a wonderful way to capture the heart, the emotions, and the essence of the characters in the Scriptures.

We will watch one episode each session and then discuss the video. If you want to watch the videos before or after the sessions, there are two free websites available. There is a study guide that will help you understand how the Scriptures are woven into the story in the episode. It provides a summary of the main characters in each episode, a summary of the content of the episode, and the Scriptures referred to in the episode.

The sessions will be 1 hour and 30 minutes on Tuesdays beginning September 3 at 2:00 - 3:30 p.m. The sessions will be September 3 through October 22.
